For pool diving, a shorty wetsuit or shorts and T shirt over swimwear would be advised. For open water diving, a semi dry suit or dry suit should be worn, according to conditions.

Junior members should be accompanied by an adult whilst at the club whenever possible.

Regular diving trips at home and abroad are arranged and all members are welcome to come along. Diving is organised to suit the experience of the diver! Costs for these trips include admission fees to dive sites, hire of equipment and a share of transport costs
