Membership Fees:

BSAC Fees per year £50 Adult £25 Juniors/Students
(Payable annually)

Club Fees per year £100 £40 Juniors
(Payable 6 monthly or annually by standing order, cheque or cash)

New members pay for 6 months on joining (£50 or £20). The remaining fee (£50 or £20) to be paid within 6 months or before the start of your open water training, whichever is the sooner. If you join to train as an Ocean Diver then the initial joining fee also includes equipment hire for 5 pool sessions (saves you £25). Club fees give you access to the Dive Pool every club night and include instruction.

For your own comfort and safety, it is recommended that you wear suitable clothing under your scuba equipment.

For pool diving, a shorty wetsuit or shorts and T shirt over swimwear would be advised. For open water diving, a wetsuit, semi-dry suit or dry suit should be worn, according to conditions.

Junior members should be accompanied by an adult whilst at the club whenever possible.

If you are unable to attend the club for a training session, then please notify a member of the committee on the club mobile or the Training Officer.

Regular diving trips at home and abroad are arranged and all members are welcome to come along. Diving is organised to suit the experience of the diver! Costs for these trips include admission fees to dive sites, hire of equipment and a share of transport costs.
